

### Know Your Plan!!!

- What is/are the main goal(s) and objectives??
- How will type of goals and objectives affect timeline and implementation?



### Goal(s) ...

- Stakeholders determine
- Examples ...
  - Education and Outreach
  - Protection
  - Need to get things cleaned up!!



### Factors May Affect Implementation

- Plan itself (age, accuracy)
- Physical (watershed size, complexity, changes, stressors/sources)
- Stakeholders/network/support
- Management measures (structural, nonstructural) - Approvals, permitting
- Technical Assistance
- Funding
- Schedule
- Monitoring



### Plan Itself

- Age, Accuracy
  - WS Plan older, but no WS change – proceed, assuming support exists



### Physical

- watershed size, complexity, changes, stressors/sources)
- Small and Simple – fewer stakeholders?
- Has watershed changed? Need more data?
- Balancing Act – analysis paralysis vs. spending resources on non-problems
- Divide, prioritize, and conquer?



### Stakeholders/network/support

- Initiated during plan development – notify folks and obtain their input
- Identify stakeholder types
  - Only want to be informed
  - Can assist – no responsibility
  - Willing to help coordinate
  - Host a structural management measure
  - Roles may change over time or task
- Sustain stakeholder interest




### Management Measures (Stakeholders/network/support)

- Structural
  - Technical Assistance
  - Permitting
  - Willing Landowners
    - public vs. private
    - Number??
  - Funding




### Management Measures (Stakeholders/network/support)

- Non-Structural
  - Legal/Technical Assistance
  - Approvals
    - Local Gov't officials, Boards, Commissions support
  - Funding



### Technical Assistance (Stakeholders/network/support)

- Division of Labor
  - Who will do what?
  - Subcontracting rules, procedures, etc.
- Structural Management Measures
  - Technical, engineering, design
- Non Structural Management Measures
  - Ordinance development, planning, legal, etc.




### Funding

- Grants
  - Timelines
  - Match

  - Business partnerships




### Schedule

- Be flexible – work with priorities, but may change
- Communication and Coordination – who can do what when?
- Milestones
  - Measurable
  - Easy to do?



### Monitoring

- What are you trying to achieve?
- More than dipping water bottles (i.e., photos)
- Use GIS to help ID monitoring locations
- Leverage/use other existing resources
